Regulation No. 66-1 Schedule 12 "Heavy Commercial Vehicles Prohibited From Using Certain Streets" is hereby amended by adding the following:


Blanchard Road from Concord Avenue to the Belmont Town Line, from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.

Dear Mr. Perkins,

On February 5, 1974, a temporary six month permit was issued to the City of Cambridge and the Town of Belmont to allow Heavy Commercial Vehicles to be restricted from Blanchard Road and Brighton Street. Since the signs have been installed, we have had no adverse reactions from the truckers or the residents in the area.

This restriction was requested after the two bridges on Alewife Brook Parkway were limited to vehicles of ten tons or less. Improvement of these bridges to allow heavy trucks will require complete reconstruction which will take about five years. We, therefore request the temporary Permit No. B-2115 dated February 5, 1974 be made permanent.
