



Fitchburg Commuter Rail Line REHABILITATION PROJECT UPDATE

Construction Advisory Belmont MA –Pearson Road to Brighton Street Overnight Work Expected

The MBTA would like to advise our neighbors in Belmont that substantial construction activity is scheduled between Pearson Road and Brighton Street to complete improvements on the inbound commuter rail track that runs adjacent to Belmont Station and Belmont High School . The work will involve the removal and replacement of track infrastructure, will be noisy at times and may be disruptive at its peak for neighbors in the area of Pearson Road to Channing Road.

This weekend, September 27th and 28th , while most work will begin at approximately 6 am and continue to approximately 10pm, it is anticipated that some work at this location will require overnight operations in order to complete track improvements during this weekend's service outage. The night work will begin approximately 2 am Saturday Morning and continue through Sunday evening.

In order to support construction efforts, ALL MBTA Fitchburg Line Commuter Rail weekend service is suspended through November 16th 2014. For more information on the weekend service suspension please go to www.MBTA.com

We apologize for any inconvenience this work and may cause. It is critical that these major construction efforts be undertaken over weekends and some nights when the track is taken out of service. These are once-in-a-generation improvements are essential to the rehabilitation of the Fitchburg Line. Customers can look forward to significant service improvements when this project is completed.
