Eastbound between Where Union Square and **Packards Corner**

HOW WILL THIS AFFECT ME?

- For bus riders: We expect a 30-40 percent reduction in travel time for the 14,000 people who ride the bus between Union Square and Packards Corner every weekday.
- For bicyclists: The shared bus/bike lane will provide **separation** between people who bike and general traffic.
- For drivers: We expect travel times along the corridor to increase by 10 seconds after a period of adjustment.

HOW WILL THIS BE **IMPLEMENTED?**


- We will install the bus/bike lane in June.
- The Boston Police Department, Boston Transportation Department, and the MBTA will work together to **enforce** the bus/bike lane.
- We will **continue to monitor** the project and make adjustments if necessary.
